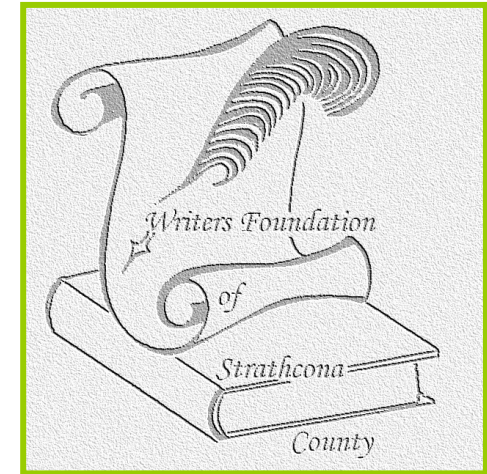

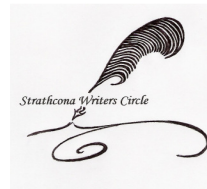

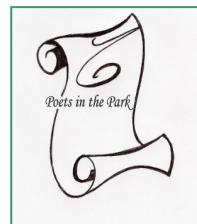


### WRITERS CIRCLE & WRITERS SHARING
